AMENDMENTS TO THE RULES OF PROCEDURE AND CONDUCT OF BUSINESS IN THE NATIONAL ASSEMBLY, 2007

“Provided further that a member may submit maximum 25 questions both starred and un-Starred from the intermediating period from prorogation of one session to prorogation of next session.”

- (2) **Amendment in sub-rule (1) of rule 158 of the Rules of Procedure.**- that in sub-rule (1) of rule 158, the following new proviso shall be added, namely:-

“Provided that a member may submit maximum 5 resolutions for a Session. On prorogation of the Session, all pending notices of resolutions shall lapse.”

Provided that the Leader of the Opposition shall have precedence over other members when taking up the questions and may ask not more than three supplementary questions.

(2) The provisions relating to questions shall apply *mutatis-mutandis* to the Prime Minister’s Question Time.”
