OF BUSINESS IN THE NATIONAL ASSEMBLY, 2007**

1. **Amendment of rule 73 of Rules of Procedure.**- that in the Rules of Procedure and Conduct of Business in the National Assembly, 2007, rule 73 may be substituted, namely:-

“73. Limit of numbers of questions.- “(1) A list for a Rota day, maximum thirty questions shall be set down including questions postponed from an earlier date or transferred to other Divisions.

(2) In case of more questions from the Members for a rota day, not more than one question from a Member shall be included in the list.

(3) A member shall submit maximum twenty questions on or after the day of prorogation of a session for the next session.

(4) The Chairperson of any Standing Committee shall not be allowed to ask question during the tenure of his/her chairpersonship.

(5) The questions of the Members from the Opposition Benches shall have precedence over questions of the Members from the Treasury Benches irrespective of the date of notice of questions.”

2. **Amendment of rule 84 of Rules of Procedure.**- that in the Rules of Procedure and Conduct of Business in the National Assembly, 2007, rule 84 may be substituted, namely:-

“Supplementary Questions.- (1) When a question has been answered, two Supplementary Questions may be allowed against each starred question to the Member who has asked such question. If the member opts to ask only one supplementary question, the second question may be asked by any other Member:

Provided that in case of absence of the Member who gave the question, both supplementary questions may be asked by any other Member (s).

(2) The Speaker shall disallow any supplementary question which, in his opinion, either infringes any provision of these rules relating to the subject-matter and admissibility of question or is otherwise an abuse of the right of asking questions.”

3. **Amendment in rule 92 of Rules of Procedure.**- that in the Rules of Procedure and Conduct of Business in the National Assembly, 2007, in rule 92, existing rule may be numbered as sub-rule (1) and new sub-rule (2), may be added after proviso namely:-

“(2) Calling Attention Notice shall be moved by the Members from the opposition benches only and in case of more than two notices, draw shall be held in the presence of all the movers of such notices.”
