**Acts, Ordinances, President's Orders and Regulations**

*Islamabad, the 19th September, 1973*

The following Act of Parliament received the assent of the President on the 17th September, 1973, and is hereby published for general information :—

**ACT NO. LXVI OF 1973**

*An Act to provide for a Federal Public Service Commission*

**WHEREAS** it is expedient to provide for a Federal Public Service Commission and for matters ancillary thereto ;

It is hereby enacted as follows :—

1. **Short title and commencement.**—(1) This Act may be called the Federal Public Service Commission Act, 1973.

(2) It shall come into force at once.

2. **Definitions.**—In this Act, unless there is anything repugnant in the subject or context,—

(a) " Commission " means the Federal Public Service Commission ;

(b) " member " means a member of the Commission and includes the Chairman thereof ; and

(c) " prescribed " means prescribed by rules made under this Act.

3. **Composition of Commission, etc.**—(1) There shall be a Federal Public Service Commission consisting of not less than three members to be appointed by the President.

(2) The President may, in addition to the members referred to in subsection (1), appoint one or more persons in the service of Pakistan to be members *ex-officio* for the discharge of such functions as he may determine.

(3) The President shall nominate one of the members to be the Chairman of the Commission.

4. **Term of office of members, etc.**—(1) A member shall hold office for three years :

Provided that the President may—

(a) extend the term of office of a member for such period as he may determine ; and

(b) for reasons to be recorded, terminate the appointment of a member before the expiration of his term of office.

(2) A member may resign his office by writing under his hand addressed to the President.

(3) The pay and other conditions of service of members shall be such as may be determined by the President.

5. **Functions of the Commission.**—The functions of the Commission shall be—

(a) to conduct tests and examinations for recruitment to—

(i) the All-Pakistan Services and such posts in connection with the affairs of the Federation: and

(ii) such posts in or under a corporation or other body or organisation set up by the Federal Government under any law, as may be prescribed: and

(b) to advise the President on such matters as may be prescribed relating to the terms and conditions of service of persons who are members of an All-Pakistan Service or hold civil posts in connection with the affairs of the Federation.

6. **Power to make rules.**—The President may, by notification in the official Gazette, make rules for carrying out the purposes of this Act, and such rules may, in particular, provide for the performance of the functions of the Commission by a Committee of two or more of its members.

7. **Repeal.**—The Federal Public Service Commission Ordinance, 1973 (XVI of 1973), is hereby repealed.
