**NOTICE**

13<sup>th</sup> meeting of the Standing Committee on **Government Assurances** will be held on **25<sup>th</sup> March 2021 at 11:00 a.m. in Constitution Room (Committee Room No. 5), 2<sup>nd</sup> Floor, Parliament House, Islamabad.** The agenda will be as under: -

- (1) Recitation from the Holy Quran;
- (2) Confirmation of minutes of previous meeting held on 06-01-2021;
- (3) Consideration of compliance reports of recommendations of previous meetings pertaining to Aviation Division;
- (4) To discuss the Assurance given by Minister for Commerce and Textile on the floor of the House on 4<sup>th</sup> December 2019 in response to starred Question No. 4 moved by honourable Ms. Fauzia Behram, MNA, whereby the House was assured that certain steps are being taken to enhance our exports to China, South Korea, Indonesia, Vietnam, Philippines, Thailand, Australia, New Zealand, Malaysia, Bangladesh, Sri Lanka, Iran, Afghanistan and the Central Asian Republics (CARS). The Ministry is required to brief the Committee on progress made, if any, subsequent to the steps enlisted in its reply to that Question.
- (5) To examine the issue pointed out by honourable Mian Najeed Ud Din Awaisi, MNA, in his letter dated 8<sup>th</sup> February 2021 which relates to discontinuation of issuance of tickets on MCOs by PIA to the family members of Parliamentarians on pretext of some software problems;
- (6) To examine the issue pointed out by honourable Mr. Muhammad Hashim Notezai, MNA, on 29-01-2021 regarding flights of PIA between Karachi to Turbat to Dilbadin, whereby the Federal Minister for Aviation, honourable Ghulam Sarwar Khan assured the august House that the Government would start two more flights between Karachi to Turbat to Quetta (Assurance # 71);
- (7) To examine the issue raised by honourable Mr. Gul Dad Khan, MNA, on 03-02-2021 regarding closure of Pak-Afghan Border, whereby the Federal Minister for Interior, honourable Sheikh Rasheed Ahmed assured the august House that he would address the issue within seven working days (Assurance # 73);
- (8) To examine the issue raised by honourable Mr. Raza Rabani Khar, MNA, regarding the death of a person and injury of another person due to electrocution while relocating electricity polls in NA-183, whereby Minister for Petroleum Division honourable Omer Ayub Khan assured the august House to investigate the issue and to deal the responsible in accordance with law (Assurance # 74);
- (9) To examine the issue raised by honourable Ms. Shagufta Jumani, MNA, on 04-02-2021 regarding over billing, load shedding and shortage of transformers in Hyderabad, whereby the Federal Minister for Power honourable Mr. Omer Ayub Khan informed the august House about registration of FIRs against the power stealers and non-cooperation of local administration. So, the issue was referred to the Standing Committee for examination (Assurance # 75); and
- (10) Any other item with permission of the chair.
