The leave applications of the Members who requested for grant of leave were read out by the honourable Speaker and granted.

**ANNOUNCEMENT**

Mr. Speaker presented the copy of Braille version of the Constitution of Pakistan in the House comprising three volumes and said that no doubt, it's a historic achievement and a reflection of our commitment that persons with disabilities should not be ignored rather their meaningful participation in the country's affairs should be ensured. Now, Pakistan stands among those few countries of the world and first in this region, whose Constitution is available on Braille. Mr. Speaker further informed this is the first step and at the same time we have made the website of the National Assembly accessible by installing special software for the people with disabilities. The Parliament Building is the first Government Building where complete disability audit has been completed, Special washrooms, for people with disabilities, have been built on each floor, special ramps have been provided and special signboards are displayed for their guidance.

In addition to this important achievement, I would like to draw the attention of all members to two important issues. In the field of Parliamentary diplomacy, the meeting of Parliamentary Assembly of Economic Cooperation Organization (ECO) was held earlier this month after a long period of nine years. Speakers from Afghanistan, Azerbaijan, Uzbekistan, Tajikistan and Turkey personally participated in it. Whereas the Speakers and delegation from Iran, Turkmenistan and Kazakhstan attended the Conference online. Although the report of this conference was tabled in the House few days ago for the information of the members, but again I would like to remind you that the success of PAECO conference is reactivation of this organization, establishment of its permanent Secretariat in Islamabad and election of the Speaker of Pakistan as the President of PAECO for the current year 2021-22. To include Kashmir issue in declaration of Islamabad and support of all countries on historical success of PAECO.

Honourable members! The elected institution of an independent and autonomous country Pakistan was established on 10 August 1947, four days earlier to the freedom of Pakistan. This historical event would complete its 74 years on 10 August 2021 and this House would enter into platinum 24 years. National Assembly Secretariat is devising a programme to celebrate this year with full vigor for which I would like to request your suggestions, support and co-operation.

## OBSERVATION MADE BY MR. SPEAKER

The National Assembly has passed the Finance Bill, 2021-22 on 29<sup>th</sup> June, 2021 after five hour ten minute long discussion. Budget session was quite exhaustive. 244 Members from Opposition and Government participated in general discussion on the Budget and consumed sixty-nine hours five minutes. Additional sixteen hours five minutes were given to opposition members for discussion, while thirteen hours to the Government members in excess of the time allotted to them. In addition to this, sixteen hours ten minutes were consumed on Demands for Grants and cut-motions and one hour and ten minutes were given for discussion on charged expenditure. Almost ninety-three hours have been given to the Budget. In addition to this, time will be given to supplementary budget today. This is a record time so far and it shows seriousness of the members of Parliament towards parliamentary oversight and their constitutional responsibility in this regard.
