
**NOTICE**

**8<sup>th</sup> meeting of the Sub Committee of the Special Committee on Persons with Disabilities will be held on Tuesday the 07<sup>th</sup> September, 2021 at 02:00 pm in the Constitution Room (old Committee Room No. 5), Second Floor, Parliament House, Islamabad** to discuss the progress made on the following recommendations and decisions of the Sub-Committee of the Special Committee on Persons with Disabilities sent to the Chairman CDA on 29<sup>th</sup> January, 2021. The time allotted for a feedback therein was two weeks and unfortunately after months it's still awaited, to which the Honorable Convener and the Members has conveyed a second displeasure.

1. Progress made on making Islamabad accessible for the PWDs after the enactment of Right for Persons with Disability Act, 2020.
2. How many markets, parks, factories and official buildings in Islamabad are accessible for the PWDs?
3. Progress made by the CDA on the implementation of Accessibility Code 2006.
4. Whether PWDs are specifically allotted plots in the previous, ongoing and planned housing schemes by the CDA.
5. Whether Itwar Bazars and public toilets in Islamabad are accessible to the PWDs.
6. Whether Islamabad Airport and Motorways leading to Islamabad are accessible to the PWDs.
7. Is CDA Hospital accessible to the PWDs?
8. How many CDA Schools are accessible to the PWDs?
9. Whether CDA's own building is accessible to the PWDs.
10. As informed by the representative of CDA during the meeting held on 04<sup>th</sup> January, 2021 at the Parliament House that 1100 existing government offices and buildings in Islamabad were issued the notices for not being PWDs friendly, the detail of it may be provided alongside the follow-up made by the CDA; and
11. *Any other Item with the permission of the Chair.*
