**AMENDMENT TO THE RULES OF PROCEDURE AND CONDUCT OF BUSINESS IN THE NATIONAL ASSEMBLY, 2007**

**Amendment in rule 169 of the Rules of Procedure.**- That in rule 169.-

- (1) in sub-rule (2), for the word "six" appearing in the second line, the word "two" shall be substituted; and
- (2) after sub-rule (2), the following new sub-rules, shall be inserted, namely:-
- "(3) If Division concerned fails to apprise the Assembly within the period as mentioned in sub-rule (2), it shall be deemed to be a breach of Privilege of the Assembly and after expiry of two months as provided in sub rule (2) on a motion moved by the Minister concerned or by any member, the matter shall be referred to the Standing Committee on Rules of Procedure and Privileges for examination and make such recommendations as it may deem fit in its report.
- (4) The report of the Committee may be either preliminary or final."
