### **RESOLUTION**

Ms. Shazia Marri, MNA moved the following resolution, which was unanimously adopted by the House:-  
“that this House recognizes this day as the International Day to combat Islamophobia, Reiterates that Islam is a religion of peace, tolerance, and acceptance;  
Categorically condemns Israel’s war on Palestine where the latest attack cost 21 lives of Palestinians standing in the line for aid during the holy month of Ramzan;  
Denounces the continued Israeli aggression which has led to the loss of over 30,000 lives since October 7<sup>th</sup>, 2023. Calls upon the Federal Government to play a more proactive role in pushing the international community to enforce a ceasefire.
