

TERMS AND CONDITIONS FOR YPF BOARD ELECTIONS

1. The Honourable Members of YPF will be eligible to contest the elections of YPF Board Office Bearers.
2. Members who already have availed two consecutive terms in the YPF Board would not be eligible to contest.
3. The nomination papers should be submitted as per the timeline of the Election Schedule.
4. The member of treasury benches can contest the election for the following positions:
 - a) President
 - b) General Secretary
 - c) Media Coordinator
5. The members of Opposition benches can contest the election for the following positions:
 - a. Vice President
 - b. Joint Secretary
 - c. Treasurer
6. Members of treasury and opposition benches will be able to vote for all the positions of YPF Board.
7. For every nomination, a Member of YPF as Proposer and other Member of YPF as Secunder shall be required.
8. Nomination papers must be filled in Member's own handwriting in Capital Letters.
9. Nomination papers can be collected, as per Election Schedule, from the Chamber of Deputy Speaker, Project Management Unit (PMU), PIPS and also can be downloaded from the National Assembly website.
10. Duly filled in nomination papers shall be submitted in the Chamber of Deputy Speaker as per Election Schedule.
