2. **SENATOR NUZHAT SADIQ** to move that the Bill to provide for special measures for the education of children suffering from dyslexia and/or associated disorders [The Dyslexia Special Measures Bill, 2022], as passed by the Senate and not passed by the National Assembly within ninety days, be taken into consideration at once under clause (3) of Article 70 of the Constitution of the Islamic Republic of Pakistan.

7. **MS. ZAHRA WADOOD FATEMI, MNA** to move that the Bill to provide for the regulation of employment of domestic workers in Islamabad Capital Territory [The Islamabad Capital Territory Domestic Workers Bill, 2022], be passed.

8. **JAM ABDUL KARIM BIJAR, MNA** to move that the Bill further to amend the Regulation of Generation, Transmission and Distribution of Electric Power Act, 1997 [The Regulation of Generation, Transmission and Distribution of Electric Power (Amendment) Bill, 2022], as passed by the National Assembly and not passed by the Senate within ninety days, be taken into consideration at once under clause (3) of Article 70 of the Constitution of the Islamic Republic of Pakistan.

9. **JAM ABDUL KARIM BIJAR, MNA** to move that the Bill further to amend the Regulation of Generation, Transmission and Distribution of Electric Power Act, 1997 [The Regulation of Generation, Transmission and Distribution of Electric Power (Amendment) Bill, 2022], be passed.
