STATEMENT MADE BY THE PRIME MINISTER

Mr. Shahid Khaqab Abbasi, Prime Minister of the Islamic Republic of Pakistan made a statement and clarified that the interview given by Mian Muhammad Nawaz Sharif, former Prime Minister of the Islamic Republic of Pakistan was misinterpreted by the Indian media. The National Security Committee meeting also condemned the mis-reporting of the statement made by former Prime Minister by the Indian Media.

TOKEN WALK OUT

Mir Aijaz Hussain Jakharani, MNA alongwith all members belonging to PPP, PTI and MQM staged a token walk-out as protest against the statement of former Prime Minister regarding the Mumbai attacks.

QUORUM

Quorum.- At 11.53 a.m. Engineer Hamid-ul-Haq, MNA belonging to PTI drew attention of the Chair towards the lack of quorum. Count was made, the House was found in order.

Mr. Speaker welcomed a group of students from Bahria University, Islamabad witnessing the proceedings of the Assembly.

MATTER REFERRED TO THE STANDING COMMITTEE

Rana Muhammad Hayat Khan, MNA rose on a point of order and drew attention of the Chair towards the alleged transfer of U.S. \$ 4.9 billion to India by Mian Muhammad Nawaz Sharif, the former Prime Minister of Pakistan and requested to refer the matter to the concerned Standing Committee, whereupon the Chairperson referred the matter to the Standing Committee on Law and Justice.

RESOLUTIONS PASSED BY THE NATIONAL ASSEMBLY

- 1) **Rana Muhammad Afzal Khan**, Minister of State for Finance and Revenue moved the motion for suspension of rules, which was adopted by the House. Dr. Shireen Mehrunsa Mazari, MNA moved the following resolution, which was unanimously passed by the National Assembly:-

“This House strongly condemns the unleashing of state terrorism by Israel against unarmed Palestinian protesters in Gaza.

This House also condemns the United States decision to violate the United Nations Security Council resolutions and shift its Embassy to Jerusalem which is presently under Israeli occupation.

This House demands that the United Nations Security Council and the international community should take action against the massacre of Palestinians by an occupation Israeli force.

- 2) **Shaikh Aftab Ahmed**, Minister for Parliamentary Affairs moved the motion for suspension of rules, which was adopted by the House. Capt. (Retd) Muhammad Safdar, MNA moved the resolution regarding construction of Air port in Hazara, which was passed by the National Assembly.
