# **OBSERVATION MADE BY MR. SPEAKER**

Mr. Speaker made an observation after breakdown of electricity in the Parliament House during the proceeding of the National Assembly and asked Sardar Awais Ahmed Khan Leghari, Minister for Power about breaskdown of electricity. Sardar Awais Ahmed Khan Leghari, Minister for Power informed the the breakdown of electricity was due to tripping of grid stations in Punjab, Khyber Pakhtunkhwa and Islamabad. He also stated that an inquiry in that regard would be conducted in that regard.
