RESOLUTION

Mian Muhammad Shahbaz Sharif, Leader of the Opposition moved the following resolution, which was unanimously passed by the National Assembly:-

“This House strongly condemns the Indian military’s attack on a civilian helicopter carrying Prime Minister of Azad Jammu and Kashmir, flying within the territory of Azad Jammu and Kashmir on 30-09-2018. The bullets were fired at the helicopter from an Indian post across the LoC.

The Indians continue to violate the ceasefire agreement besides committing atrocities in the Indian Occupied Kashmir although they have miserably failed to suppress the will and the resolve of Kashmiri people who are fighting for their right of self determination.

This House strongly condemns this cowardly act of state aggression and violation of International laws.”

The sitting of the Assembly was adjourned to meet again on Tuesday, the 2nd October, 2018 at 10.00 a.m.
