## **RESOLUTION PASSED BY THE NATIONAL ASSEMBLY**

Mr. Ali Amin Khan, Minister for Kashmir Affairs and Gilgit Baltistan moved the following resolution, which was unanimously passed by the National Assembly:-

“

- This House commemorating the Black Day of Indian occupation of Jammu and Kashmir on 27<sup>th</sup> October, 1947, condemns the unabated state terrorism by the Indian forces and blatant violation of international laws in Indian Occupied Kashmir.
- This House strongly condemns the killing of more than 90 thousand innocent Kashmiris (who are martyred) in Indian Occupied Kashmir by Indian occupying forces.
- This House rejects the conduct of sham elections in Indian Occupied Kashmir by the Indian government, the failure of which speaks volumes about the alienation of the people of Indian Occupied Kashmir from the illegal Indian rule.
- This House urges the international community for the expedited formation of the Commission

of Inquiry to investigate the gross human rights violations in Indian Occupied Kashmir, as recommended by the office of the High Commissioner for Human Rights.

- This House reaffirms its solidarity and commitment to the people of Indian Occupied Kashmir in their just struggle for their rights to self determination and reiterates its continuing political, moral and diplomatic support for this just struggle in line with the United Nations Security Council resolutions.
