Terms of Reference

The Committee shall,-

- (a) review laws for protection of rights of persons with disabilities;
- (b) suggest legislative measures and amendments where required for welfare of persons with disabilities;
- (c) report on implementation status of laws pertaining to persons with disabilities and International Convention on the Rights of the Persons with Disabilities and the International Labour Organization (ILO) Convention on Vocational Rehabilitation and Employment of Disabled Persons;
- (d) take note of abuse of rights of persons with disabilities and suggest remedial measures; and
- (e) any other matter referred to the Committee by the House or Speaker, as the case may be, pertaining to rights of persons with disabilities

The Honourable Speaker may be authorized to make such changes in the composition of the Committee as and when required. The Committee will present its report to the House.”
