## ADJOURNMENT MOTION

**Syed Naveed Qamar, MNA** moved the following Adjournment Motion which was not opposed and leave was granted:-

“that under rule 110 of the Rules of Procedure and Conduct of business in the National Assembly, 2007 to discuss the horrific matter of urgent public importance regarding the recent increase in electricity prices. The government has dropped another inflation bomb on already inflation-stricken masses on 21<sup>st</sup> January, 2021 by increasing per unit cost of electricity by Rs. 1.95/- This increase will lead to a further increase in the rate of inflation in the country. It is noteworthy that instead of improving the transmission system and minimizing the losses, the Federal Government is adopting an easy way of burdening the people by increasing the rate of electricity.

Likewise, one of the major reasons for the continuous increase in the Prices of electricity is the failure of Federal Government to control circular debt of the power sector. As per reports, power sector’s circular debt went past Rs. 2.30/- trillion, and it has been increasing at a rate of Rs. 31.2 billion per month. The increase in circular debt shows poor governance of the incumbent government in power sector.

It is therefore, requested to suspend the routing proceedings of the House and discuss the matter, immediately.”
