SENATOR MOHSIN AZIZ to move that the Bill to amend the Regulation of Generation, Transmission and Distribution of Eclectic Power Act, 1997 [The Regulation of Generation, Transmission and Distribution of Electric Power (Amendment) Bill, 2021], as passed by Senate and not passed by the National Assembly within ninety days, be taken into consideration at once under clause (3) of Article 70 of the Constitution of the Islamic Republic of Pakistan.
