#### **RULING GIVEN BY MR. SPEAKER**

**Mr. Speaker** gave ruling that the Ordinances which are being extended for a further period of 120 days under Article 89 of the Constitution of the Islamic Republic of Pakistan do not contain any provision relating to punishment which cannot be inflicted retrospectively under Article 12 of the Constitution of the Islamic Republic of Pakistan.

Since, there are many precedents available regarding enforcement of laws retrospectively which do not contain provision relating to punishment. Therefore there is no embargo in extension of these Ordinances by the National Assembly retrospectively. Even otherwise the Resolutions for extension of Ordinances have been placed in the Orders of the Day since the commencement of current session, however, could not be taken up due to adjournment of the sittings without transaction of business due to lack of quorum or otherwise.

Therefore, I held the objection out of order and allow the extension of the Ordinances retrospectively by the National Assembly.
