**RULING OF THE CHAIR**

A Resolution for vote of no-confidence against the Prime Minister was submitted by the Opposition on 8<sup>th</sup> March, 2022. Resolution for vote of No-confidence should be in accordance with the Constitution, law and Rules. No foreign country has right to topple the Government elected by the People of Pakistan. The points raised by the Minister for Law and Justice are correct and valid, therefore, I give ruling that Resolution for vote of no-confidence is contrary to the Constitution, national sovereignty, independence, rules and procedure. Therefore, I hereby give ruling to disallow and reject the Resolution.

Soon after, the ruling, Mr. Deputy Speaker read out the prorogation Order to prorogue the National Assembly session summoned on 25<sup>th</sup> March, 2022

The sitting of the National Assembly was called to meet on 9<sup>th</sup> April, 2022 at 10.00 a.m. by the Speaker.
