## **RESOLUTION**

Mr. Mohsin Dawar, MNA moved the following Resolution which was unanimously adopted by the House:-

“This House resolves that under the Constitution of the Islamic Republic of Pakistan obedience to the Constitution and law is the inviolable obligation of every citizen wherever he may be and of every other person for the time being within Pakistan.

According to oath of the office of the President, the President will not allow his personal interest to influence his official conduct or his official decisions. He is also bound to preserve, protect and defend the Constitution.

This House takes strong exception to the unconstitutional stance taken by the President and refusal to adhere to implement the Constitution in letter and spirit and also to follow the norms of Parliamentary democracy.

This House calls upon the President to act in a nonpartisan manner and to perform his functions strictly in accordance with Article 48 of the Constitution.”
