**RESOLUTION PASSED BY THE MAJLIS-E-SHOORA
(PARLIAMENT) IN JOINT SITTING**

Mian Riaz Hussain Pirzada, Minister for Human Rights moved the following Resolution which was unanimously adopted by the House:-

“This House shows solidarity with the family of Hurriyat Leader Mr. Yasin Malik, who is being persecuted in a manifestly dubious and motivated case in the Indian Illegally Occupied Jammu and Kashmir.

This House condemns the abhorrent attempt of the Indian Government to deprive the Kashmiri people of their true leadership, which is the blatant violation of Universal Declaration of Human Rights (UDHR) and International Covenant on civil and political rights (ICCPR).

This House stresses that the struggle for the right of self-determination in Kashmir is indigenous and cannot be dampened by the draconian strong-arm tactics of the Indian Government.

This House resolves that Government of Pakistan should take immediate steps and urges international community to counsel India to drop all fabricated charges against all political leaders of Indian Illegally Occupied Jammu and Kashmir including Mr. Yasin Malik, ensure their safety and well-being, and also arrange his meeting with his spouse “Ms. Mishal Malik” along with 10 years old daughter, and to stop human rights violations in Kashmir, lift the brutal military siege, and let the Kashmiri people exercise their right to self-determination in accordance with their aspirations and relevant UN Security Council Resolutions.”
