**Amendment in rule 239 of the Rules of Procedure.**- That in the Rules of Procedure and Conduct of Business in the National Assembly, 2007, in rule 239, in sub-rule (1), for the words “in consultation with”, the words “under intimation to”, shall be substituted.

### NOTIFICATION

**S.R.O.** The following amendments made by the National Assembly in the Rules of Procedure and Conduct of Business in the National Assembly, 2007, on the 20<sup>th</sup> October, 2022, under rule 293 of the aforesaid rules, are published for general information:-

(i) **Substitution of rule 103 of the Rules of Procedure.**- In the Rules of Procedure and Conduct of Business in the National Assembly, 2007, hereinafter referred to as the said Rules, for rule 103, the following shall be substituted, namely:-

**“103. Approval of the Speaker before arrest, detention, etc., of a member.-** When a member has to be arrested on a criminal charge or for a criminal offence or has to be detained under an executive order, the committing judge, magistrate or executive authority, as the case may be, shall immediately seek approval of the Speaker indicating the reasons for the arrest or detention, as the case may be, and after such arrest, detention or when a member is sentenced to imprisonment by a court of law, the committing judge, magistrate or executive authority, as the case may be shall intimate the place of detention or imprisonment of the member in the appropriate form set out in the Fourth Schedule.

(ii) **Substitution of rule 106 of the Rules of Procedure.**- In the said Rules, for rule 106, the following shall be substituted, namely:-

**“106. Arrest within the precincts of the Assembly.-** No member shall be arrested within the precincts of the Assembly.”

(iii) **Amendment in rule 108 of the Rules of Procedure.**- In the aid Rules, in rule 108,-

(a) in sub-rule (1) for the word “may” the word “shall”, shall be substituted, and the words, “if he considers his presence necessary”, shall be omitted.

(b) after sub-rule (2), the following new sub-rule (3), shall be added:-

**“(3) The Speaker shall declare the Parliament Lodges or any other suitable place in Islamabad as sub-Jail.”**
