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**RESOLUTION PASSED BY THE HOUSE**

Mr. Murtaza Javed Abbasi, Minister for Parliamentary Affairs moved the following Resolution which was adopted by the House:-

“that this House is of the opinion that uninterrupted natural gas may be supplied to the commercial sector comprising of small hotels, restaurants, bakers, cafes, food centers, etc. and the notices regarding discontinuation of natural gas to commercial sector and to shift them on RLNG be withdrawn forthwith. These notices are injustice to daily wage laborers and poor workers earning their livelihood from these commercial centers. This sector is only consuming 2.4 percent of natural gas as compared to domestic sector consuming 15.9 percent, fertilizer sector consuming 5.2 percent, industrial sector consuming 19.4 percent, power plants consuming 32.4 percent and capital power plants consuming 4.2 percent of natural gas.

This House therefore recommends that notices issued to shift the commercial sector on RLNG may be withdrawn and uninterrupted supply of natural gas may be continued to the commercial sector.”
