#### "Committee on Scrutiny of Delegated Legislation

- **205-A.** Composition.-A Standing Committee, to be called the Committee on Scrutiny of Delegated Legislation shall be appointed by the Speaker of the National Assembly at the commencement of every National Assembly. The Committee shall be nominated for the term of the National Assembly:-
  - (a) The Committee shall consist of not less than fifteen members.
  - (b) The Committee shall have the power to send for persons, papers, and records.
  - (c) The Committee may make its own rules.

**205-B.** Functions of Committee.-(1) The Committee shall examine all regulations, rules, byelaws and statutory regulations, orders made or given under any law, or ordinance after an order, regulation, or bye-law is published in the Gazette, a copy is to be made available to the Secretariat of the National Assembly which will table it in the Committee on Scrutiny of Delegated Legislation. The Committee in turn shall examine the order for the following:-
