اس امر کو اجاگر کرتا ہے کہ پانچ اگست 2019 کو بھارت کی جانب سے ایک طرفہ طور پر اٹھائے گئے غیر قانونی اقدامات کے نتیجے میں ہر سال پانچ اگست کے دن یوم استحصال کے طور پر منایا جاتا ہے جو کہ بھارتی غیر قانونی مقبوضہ جموں و کشمیر پر اپنا تسلط قائم رکھنے کے بھارتی عزائم کو ظاہر کرتا ہے۔

اپنے حق خود ارادیت کے اصول کی منصفانہ جدوجہد میں کشمیر کی مظلوم عوام کے ساتھ اظہار یکجہتی کرتا ہے۔

اس بات کی یاد دلاتا ہے کہ تنازعہ جموں و کشمیر اقوام متحدہ کے ایجنڈے پر تاحال موجود غیر تصفیہ شدہ اور دیرینہ بین الاقوامی تنازعات میں سے ایک ہے۔

اس امر کو ذہن نشین کراتا ہے کہ سال 1948 سے اب تک مسئلہ جموں و کشمیر پر اقوام متحدہ کی سلامتی کونسل کی متعدد قراردادیں منظور کی جا چکی ہیں۔

حق خود ارادیت کے حصول کی کشمیری عوام کی جدوجہد کے لیے پاکستان کی غیر متزلزل اخلاقی سفارتی اور سیاسی حمایت کا اعادہ کرتا ہے۔

بھارتی غیر قانونی مقبوضہ جموں و کشمیر کے لوگوں کے حوصلے اور قربانیوں کو زبردست خراج تحسین پیش کرتا ہے۔

15 اگست 2019 سے بھارت کے ایک طرفہ اور غیر قانونی اقدامات کو مسترد کرنے کا اعادہ کرتا ہے اور بھارتی غیر قانونی مقبوضہ جموں و کشمیر کے آبادیاتی ڈھانچے اور سیاسی منظر نامے کو تبدیل کرنے کی مسلسل کوششوں پر گہری تشویش کا اظہار کرتا ہے۔

اس بات پر زور دیتا ہے کہ بھارتی دستور کے تابع کوئی بھی سیاسی عمل جموں و کشمیر کے لوگوں کے حق خود ارادیت استعمال کرنے کا متبادل نہیں ہو سکتا جیسا کہ اقوام متحدہ کی سلامتی کونسل کی قراردادوں میں وضاحت کی گئی ہے۔

لاکھوں بھارتی افواج کی موجودگی پر شدید تشویش کا اظہار کرتا ہے۔ جس سے بھارتی غیر قانونی مقبوضہ جموں و کشمیر دنیا کے سب سے زیادہ عسکری خطوں میں سے ایک بن چکا ہے۔

بھارتی غیر قانونی مقبوضہ جموں و کشمیر میں جاری انسانی حقوق کی خلاف ورزیوں کی مذمت کرتا ہے اور ہزاروں کشمیری سیاسی قیدیوں کی مسلسل اسیری پر شدید تشویش کا اظہار کرتا ہے۔

ایسے استثنائی مذمت کرتا ہے جس سے بھارتی افواج انصاف کی نفی کرنے والے غاصبانہ قوانین کے تحت بھارتی غیر قانونی مقبوضہ جموں و کشمیر میں انسانی حقوق کی خلاف ورزیاں جاری رکھے ہوئے ہیں۔

آزاد جموں و کشمیر اور گلگت بلتستان کے حوالہ سے بھارتی رہنماؤں کے ان غیر ذمہ دارانہ بیانات کو مسترد کرتا ہے جو علاقائی امن و استحکام کے لیے خطرہ ہے۔ اور یہ کہ پاکستانی قوم کسی بھی جارحانہ اقدام کو ناکام بنانے کے لیے غیر متزلزل عزم کا اعادہ کرتی ہے۔

مطالبہ کرتا ہے کہ بھارت کشمیری سیاسی قیدیوں کو رہا کرے۔ انسانی حقوق کی جاری خلاف ورزیوں کو روکے اور اقوام متحدہ کی سلامتی کونسل کی متعلقہ قراردادوں پر سنجیدگی سے عمل درآمد کرائے تاکہ کشمیری عوام اقوام متحدہ کی سرپرستی میں منصفانہ اور غیر جانبدارانہ استصواب رائے کے جمہوری طریقہ کار کے ذریعے اپنے مستقبل کا تعین کر سکیں۔
