اس امر کو ذہن نشین کرا تا ہے کہ سال 1948 سے اب تک مسلہ جموں و کشمیر پر اقوام متحدہ کی سلامتی کونسل کی متعدد قرار دادیں منظور کی جاچکی ہیں۔

حق خود ارادیت کے حصول کی کشمیری عوام کی جدوجہد کے لیے پاکستان کی غیر متز لزل اخلاقی سفارتی اور سیاسی حمایت کااعادہ کرتا ہے۔

بھارتی غیر قانونی مقبوضہ جمول وکشمیر کے لوگوں کے حوصلے اور قربانیوں کو زبر دست خراج تحسین پیش کر تاہے۔ 5 اگست 2019 سے بھارت کے یک طرفہ اور غیر قانونی اقدامات کو مستر دکرنے کا اعادہ کر تاہے اور بھارتی غیر قانونی مقبوضہ جموں کشمیر کے آبادیاتی ڈھانچے اور ساسی منظرنامے کو تبدیل کرنے کی مسلسل کو ششوں پر گہری تشویش کا اظہار کرتاہے۔

اس بات پر زور دیتا ہے کہ بھارتی دستور کے تابع کوئی بھی سیاسی عمل جموں و کشمیر کے لو گوں کے حق خود ارادیت استعال کرنے کا متبادل نہیں ہو سکتا جیسا کہ اقوام متحدہ کی سلامتی کو نسل کی قرار دادوں میں وضاحت کی گئی ہے۔

لا کھوں بھارتی افواج کی موجودہ گی پر شدید تشویش کا اظہار کر تاہے۔ جس سے بھارتی غیر قانونی مقبوضہ جموں و کشمیر دنیا کے سب سے زیادہ عسکری خطوں میں سے ایک بن چکاہے۔

بھارتی غیر قانونی مقبوضہ جموں و کشمیر میں جاری انسانی حقوق کی خلاف ورزیوں کی مذمت کر تاہے اور ہز اروں کشمیری سیاسی قیدیوں کی مسلسل اسیری پر شدید تشویش کا اظہار کر تاہے۔

ایسے استثناکی مذمت کرتاہے جس سے بھارتی افواج انصاف کی نفی کرنے والے غاصبانہ قوانین کے تحت بھارتی غیر قانونی مقبوضہ جموں وکشمیر میں انسانی حقوق کی خلاف ورزیاں جاری رکھے ہوئے ہیں۔

آزاد جموں و کشمیر اور گلگت بلتستان کے حوالہ سے بھارتی رہنماؤں کے ان غیر ذمہ دارانہ بیانات کو مستر دکر تا ہے جو علا قائی امن و استحکام کے لیے خطرہ ہے۔ اور یہ کہ پاکستانی قوم کسی بھی جار حانہ اقدام کوناکام بنانے کے لیے غیر متز لزل عزم کا اعادہ کرتی ہے۔ مطالبہ کرتا ہے کہ بھارت کشمیری سیاسی قیدیوں کو رہا کر ہے۔ انسانی حقوق کی جاری خلاف ورزیوں کو روکے اور اقوام متحدہ کی سلامتی کونسل کی متعلقہ قرار دادوں پر سنجیدگی سے عمل درآ مدکرائے تا کہ کشمیری عوام اقوام متحدہ کی سرپر ستی میں منصفانہ اور غیر جانبدارانہ استصواب رائے کے جمہوری طریقہ کار کے ذریعے اپنے مستقبل کا تعین کر سکیں۔
