- (ii) After the expression "Senate.", the expression, "the Chairman of the Committee shall be from the National Assembly. The National Assembly Secretariat will be the Secretariat of the Committee, The Rules of Procedure for the Parliamentary Committee on Kashmir, 2021 shall apply to the Parliamentary Committee on Kashmir.", shall be added."
