 - **"39C.** The Cabinet shall collectively be responsible to the National Assembly, in accordance with Clause (6) of Article 91 of the Constitution of the Islamic Republic of Pakistan;
 - **39D**. The Minister shall assume primary responsibility for the disposal of business pertaining to his or her portfolio; and
 - **39E.** In cases of emergency, and with the prior approval of the Speaker, the Parliamentary Secretary may be allowed to assume the parliamentary functions of the Minister of the respective ministry or division, subject to prior intimation to the National Assembly".
