RESOLUTION

Senator Mr. Azam Nazeer Tarar, Minister for Law and Justice moved the following resolution, which was unanimously adopted by the House:-

“While recalling and reaffirming the Resolution passed by this National Assembly dated August 2, 2024, this House once again:

- **Strongly condemns** the ongoing heinous wave of atrocities by the Zionist Israeli regime;
- **Notes** with utter disgust that the latest Israeli offensive, resumed on March 18, has resulted in the killing of 1600 innocent Palestinians, bringing the total toll to over 65,000 deaths in Gaza;
- **Rebukes** severely the ruthless destruction of complete civic infrastructure, including Housing, Hospitals, Schools and places of worship by the barbaric Israeli bombing;
- **Expresses** unwavering solidarity with the Palestinian brothers and sisters in their just struggle, and reaffirms their inalienable right of self-determination and to their motherland;
- **Dismayed** over the persistent failure of the international community to halt to Israeli aggression, and calls urgently for an immediate, permanent, and comprehensive ceasefire, along with the delivery of uninterrupted and sustainable humanitarian assistance to the besieged and beleaguered Palestinians;
- **Demands** the immediate and unconditional withdrawal of Israeli occupying forces from the Gaza Strip, in

line with United Nations Security Council Resolution 2735 (2024);

- **Urges** the international community to take concrete steps toward the recognition and admission of the State of Palestine as a full Member of the United Nations;
