**WELCOME**

Mr. Speaker welcomed the group of students and faculty members from Punjab University, Law Department, Jhelum Campus, who were witnessing the proceedings of the House in the visitor's gallery.

**ANNOUNCEMENT**

Mr. Speaker congratulated the President of the Oxford University Union Mr. Mossa Harraj and two former Member President Mr. Israr Khan Kakar and Mr. Ahmed Nawaz for taking the initiative to arrange a debate on the topic, "India's Policy Towards Pakistan is a Populous Strategy Sold as Security Policy".

The Indian side anticipating an imminent defeat, withdrew from the debate at the eleventh hour. Such a forfeiture at so high profile and reputable forum was clearly a victory of Pakistan's longstanding narrative and official stance about Indian high handed conduct as its aspiration to act as a regional policeman.

## RESOLUTION

The following resolution was moved by Ms. Shamaila Rana, MNA,:-

“This House strongly condemns the statement given by Mehmood Khan Achakzai, MNA, on 28-11-2025, regarding hate and stopping the proceeding of Parliament by using force. This statement is contemptuous against the mandate of the people of Pakistan and direct attack on the Parliament.

Parliament is Supreme as it embodies the will of the people and is an organ of the State under Article 7 of Constitution. Under Article 16 and 17 of the Constitution, the fundamental right of assembly and associations are subject to reasonable restriction imposed by law in the interest of sovereignty or integrity of Pakistan, public order or morality.

This House therefore recommends that the Government should take strict action as per Constitution and law against persons who are making such statement and instigating people against the Parliament, thus creating law and order situation in the country. Such an action may include but not limited to suspension of Membership, reference of disqualification and stoppage of salary benefit allowance of said MNA.
