NOTICE

12th meeting of the Standing Committee on **Overseas Pakistanis and Human Resource Development** will be held on **Tuesday, the 6th January, 2026 at 11:00 a.m. in Constitution Room (old Committee Room No. 5), Second Floor, Parliament House, Islamabad,** to discuss the following agenda: -

- 1) Confirmation of minutes of previous meeting held on 17th December, 2025;
 - 2) Comprehensive report / implementation status of the previous recommendations of the Committee;
 - 3) Comprehensive performance briefing by Community Welfare Attachés (CWAs) posted in the Gulf region on verified and independently validated data, including a third-party audit of reported performance figures, to ensure accuracy, credibility, and reliability;
 - 4) The briefing may, inter alia, cover:
 - a. independent verification of data relating to labour disputes, deaths, compensation claims, legal aid cases, detention matters, and repatriation of Pakistani workers;
 - b. evaluation of the quality, timeliness, and effectiveness of services provided by CWAs, including issuance of emergency travel documents, recovery of unpaid dues, coordination for legal assistance, family facilitation, and repatriation support;
 - c. identification of persistent operational challenges, such as employer non-cooperation, host-country legal and procedural hurdles, documentation deficiencies, staffing limitations, and inadequate outreach mechanisms;
 - d. an evidence-based assessment of complaints and perceptions among Pakistani migrant workers regarding non-responsiveness or inadequate support by Pakistani officials abroad, with distinction between systemic shortcomings, capacity constraints, procedural delays, and unfounded perceptions, based on:
 - analysis of complaint records and response timelines;
 - feedback from migrant workers and community representatives; and
 - findings of the third-party audit.
 - 5) Assessment of the role of CWAs in facilitating export of manpower, including liaison with host-country authorities, employers, and recruitment agencies, and support to legal, transparent, and demand-driven overseas employment, in line with the approved job description of the Community Welfare Attaché (CWA);
 - 6) An outcome-based evaluation of CWAs performance during the last three years, including facilitation of job opportunities, resolution of recruitment-related issues, employer outreach initiatives, contribution towards sustaining or enhancing manpower export, and comparison of reported achievements with verifiable outcomes on the ground.
 - 7) Identification of the performance gaps, determining whether reported achievements and complaints reflect ground realities, and propose corrective and remedial measures where deficiencies are established; and
 - 8) Any other item with permission of the Chair.
