## MOTION FOR SUSPENSION OF MEMEBR

Ms. Farah Naz Akbar, Parliamentary Secretary for National Heritage and Culture Division, moved the following motion, which was adopted by the House.

“that during the proceedings of the National Assembly on 3<sup>rd</sup> April, 2026, Mr. Muhammad Iqbal Khan, MNA (NA-27), was observed using abusive language towards the Director General (Media) of the National Assembly Secretariat and issuing threats. On multiple occasions, he has also misbehaved with police and security personnel deployed for security duties within the Secretariat, as well as with the Chair.

Furthermore, on 13<sup>th</sup> May, 2026, he undermined the authority of the Chair and lowered the dignity of Parliament by using abusive and threatening language against fellow members, thereby disrupting the decorum and discipline of the House. His conduct is unbecoming of a parliamentarian, as he has repeatedly violated the sanctity of the House, disregarded the authority of the Chair, and willfully obstructed the proceedings in contravention of the Rules.

In view of the above, I hereby name him under Rule 21 of the Rules of Procedure and Conduct of Business in the National Assembly, 2007. I now put the question to the House whether Mr. Muhammad Iqbal Khan, MNA, should be suspended from the service of the Assembly for the remainder of the session.
