AMENDMENT TO THE RULES OF PROCEDURE AND CONDUCT OF BUSINESS IN THE NATIONAL ASSEMBLY, 2007

“(4) The date of submission of the resignation of a member shall be the date specified in writing by the member, or, if no date is specified, the date of receipt of such resignation by the Speaker. Such resignation shall only be deemed effective on the date the Speaker formally accepts the resignation in writing. During the period between the submission of the resignation and its acceptance by the Speaker, the member shall not be entitled to receive any pay, allowances, or privileges otherwise admissible to a sitting member under any law, rule, or statute.”.
