2. **SENATOR AZAM NAZEER TARAR**, Minister for Law and Justice to move that the Bill to provide for the protection of parents [The Protection of Parents Bill, 2023], as passed by the National Assembly and not passed by the Senate within ninety days, be taken into consideration at once under clause (3) of Article 70 of the Constitution of the Islamic Republic of Pakistan.

3. **SENATOR AZAM NAZEER TARAR**, Minister for Law and Justice to move that the Bill to provide for the protection of parents [The Protection of Parents Bill, 2023], be passed.
