If objection is taken, the Speaker shall “after permitting a brief explanatory statement from the member and the Minister opposing it.”, call such of the members as may be in favour of leave being granted to rise in their seats, and, if the majority of the members present does not so rise, the Speaker shall declare that the member has not leave of the Assembly, or, if no objection is taken or such “members” so rises, the Speaker shall declare that the member has the leave of the Assembly.”
