- “(6) In relation to each Ministry’s annual budgetary proposals comprising of demands for grants and appropriations and development expenditure for the next fiscal year, -
- (a) each Ministry shall submit its annual budgetary proposals for the next fiscal year to the concerned Standing Committee not later than the 30th January;
 - (b) the Standing Committee concerned shall scrutinize the proposals and recommend to the National Assembly amendments therein, not later than the 20th February, if necessary, provided that if the recommendations are not made by any concerned Standing Committee by the 20th February, such budgetary proposals may be forwarded to the National Assembly for consideration; and
 - (c) the National Assembly shall finalize the recommendations in a pre-budget session not later than the 5th March and such recommendations may be incorporated by the concerned Ministry in its budgetary proposals for next fiscal year.”
