AMENDMENTS TO THE RULES OF PROCEDURE AND CONDUCT OF BUSINESS IN THE NATIONAL ASSEMBLY, 2007.

AMENDMENT IN RULE 227. In the Rules of Procedure and Conduct of Business in the National Assembly, 2007, in rule 227.-

- (i) In sub-rule (1), for the word "Chairman" the word "Committee" shall be substituted; and
- (ii) In sub-rule (3), for the word "Chairman" the word "Committee" shall be substituted.

8. **MRS. KASHMALA TARIQ**, to move, if leave is granted, under sub-rule (5) of rule 293 of the Rules of Procedure and Conduct of Business in the National Assembly, 2007, that the proposed amendments be taken into consideration.

9. **DR. DONYA AZIZ**, to seek leave under sub-rule (4) of rule 293 of the Rules of Procedure and Conduct of Business in the National Assembly, 2007 to move the following amendments:

1. **AMENDMENT IN RULE - 182.** In the Rules of Procedure and Conduct of Business in the National Assembly, 2007, in rule 182, for sub-clause (2), the following shall be substituted.

“(2) No Demands for Grant shall be made except on the recommendation of the government as approved by the Standing Committees at least one month prior to the presentation of the budget in the Parliament.”

2. **AMENDMENT IN RULE – 201.** In rule 201, the following new sub-clauses (6) and (7) shall be added at the end, namely, -

“(6) The Standing Committees shall be presented with the proposed Demands for Grant of its relevant ministry at least 45 days before the presentation of the budget in the National Assembly. The Committee will amend and approve the said Demands for Grant at least 15 days before the presentation of the budget in the Parliament.

(7) Any supplementary Demands for Grant made by the Government must be approved by the Ministry’s relevant Committee at least 15 days before being presented in the Parliament.”
