(insertion of sections 306A, 324A, etc in the Pakistan Penal Code, 1860 and insertion of new sections in the Schedule II of the Code of Criminal Procedure 1898).

AMENDMENTS TO THE RULES OF PROCEDURE AND CONDUCT OF BUSINESS IN THE NATIONAL ASSEMBLY, 2007

17. **DR. DONYA AZIZ**, to seek leave under sub-rule (4) of rule 293 of the Rules of Procedure and Conduct of Business in the National Assembly, 2007 to move the following amendments:

- (1) **AMENDMENT IN RULE 69.** In the Rules of Procedure and Conduct of Business in the National Assembly, 2007, in rule 69, for the word “hour” the words “ninety minutes” shall be substituted.
- (2) **AMENDMENT IN RULE 75.** In the Rules of Procedure and Conduct of Business in the National Assembly, 2007, in rule 75, in the proviso, for the word “unstarred” occurring at the end of fourth line, the word “starred” shall be substituted.
- (3) **AMENDMENT IN RULE 82.** In the Rules of Procedure and Conduct of Business in the National Assembly, 2007, in rule 82, the following new sub-rules shall be added at the end, and the existing rule shall be re-numbered as sub-rule (1), namely:-
 - “(2) The number of questions on the list of questions for any day shall not exceed 20; and
 - (3) One question put to each of the Divisions for which time has been allotted will be placed in sequence in the list of questions and the sequence will be repeated until the questions of the list are exhausted.”
- (4) **AMENDMENT IN RULE 201.** In the Rules of Procedure and Conduct of Business in the National Assembly, 2007, in rule 201, in sub-rule (1), the following proviso shall be added at the end, namely:-

“Provided that any Bill which has been introduced in the Assembly and referred to a Standing Committee will be taken up for consideration by the Committee within 30 days of its introduction in the National Assembly. Once the Committee begins consideration of a Bill, the Committee will conclude its deliberations and present its report to the Assembly within 30 days.”
- (5) **AMENDMENT IN RULE 250.** In the Rules of Procedure and Conduct of Business in the National Assembly, 2007, in rule 250, in the proviso, between the words “Bill” and “and”, comma and word “question” shall be inserted.

18. **DR. DONYA AZIZ** to move, if leave is granted, under sub-rule (5) of rule 293 of the Rules of Procedure and Conduct of Business in the National Assembly, 2007, that the proposed amendments be taken into consideration.

19. **MR. S. A. IQBAL QADRI**, to seek leave under sub-rule (4) of rule 293 of the Rules of Procedure and Conduct of Business in the National Assembly 2007 to move the following amendments:

- (1) **AMENDMENT IN RULE 84.** In the Rules of Procedure and Conduct of Business in the National Assembly, 2007, in rule 84 between the words “a” and “question” occurring in the first line the word “starred” shall be inserted.
- (2) **AMENDMENT IN RULE 194:** In sub-rule (4) of rule 194 of the Rules of Procedure and Conduct of Business in the National Assembly, 2007, for the brackets and figure “(iii)” the brackets and letter “(c)” shall be substituted.
- (3) **AMENDMENT IN RULE 250:** In the Rules of Procedure and Conduct of Business in the National Assembly, 2007, for the first proviso to rule 250, the following shall be substituted, namely:-

“Provided that notices of intention to move for leave to introduce a Bill or a motion for leave to amend these Rules, a notice of amendment in a Bill, or notice of question and a question of privilege shall not lapse.”

20. MR. S. A. IQBAL QADRI, to move, if leave is granted, under sub-rule (5) of rule 293 of the Rules of Procedure and Conduct of Business in the National Assembly, 2007, that the proposed amendments be taken into consideration.

21. SYED ALLA-UD-DIN, to seek leave under sub-rule (4) of rule 293 of the Rules of Procedure and Conduct of Business in the National Assembly, 2007 to move the following amendments:

1. **INSERTION OF NEW RULE 86A**. In the Rules of Procedure and Conduct of Business in the National Assembly, 2007, after rule 86, the following new rule 86A, shall be added, namely:-

“86A. (1) If any member during the question hour or afterwards brings into the notice of the Speaker that the answer of the starred or unstarred question is based on wrong information, the Speaker may give opportunity to the Minister concerned to explain to the satisfaction of the member who has given the notice of the question;

(2) If the member concerned is still not satisfied from the explanation he or any other member may move a motion to refer the matter to a Special Committee to be constituted under rule 244(B);

(3) The Committee in the presence of the member concerned will proceed and submit its report to the House within thirty days, extendable by the Speaker for any pragmatic reason but not more than thirty days;

(4) If the House is not in session the report of the Committee will be taken up in the first sitting after the question hour; and

(5) The report of the Committee shall state the actual misreporting and the names of the officials involved therein and further recommend the action to be taken.”

22. SYED ALLA-UD-DIN, to move, if leave is granted, under sub-rule (5) of rule 293 of the Rules of Procedure and Conduct of Business in the National Assembly, 2007, that the proposed amendments be taken into consideration.
