AMENDMENTS TO THE RULES OF PROCEDURE AND CONDUCT OF BUSINESS IN THE NATIONAL ASSEMBLY, 2007.

17. **SYED ALLA-UD-DIN**, to seek leave under sub-rule (4) of rule 293 of the Rules of Procedure and Conduct of Business in the National Assembly 2007 to move the following amendments:

(1) **SUBSTITUTION OF RULE 18:** In the Rules of Procedure and Conduct of Business in the National Assembly, 2007, for rule 18, the following shall be substituted, namely: -

“18. **Raising a matter which is not a point of order.**- (1) The last hour of every sitting except on Fridays, shall be available for raising a matter which is not a point of order and the Speaker will allow the members in order of their notices given one day before the sitting in which they want to raise the matter.

(2) The Speaker may dispense with the requirement of notice period and allow a member to raise such matter.

(3) The member raising the matter shall culminate the description of the matter in the time allotted by the Speaker to the member or to a party which that party may further divide among its members.

(4) The Speaker will decide the admissibility of the matter and the matter should be in the form of a complaint against the Government or a proposal or a piece of advice to the government narrated in the precise and concise parliamentary words devoid of defamation, insulting impression, disparaging or mud-slinging or provocation.”
