- (1) **AMENDMENT IN RULE 84.** In the Rules of Procedure and Conduct of Business in the National Assembly, 2007, in rule 84 between the words “a” and “question” occurring in the first line the word “starred” shall be inserted.

- (2) **AMENDMENT IN RULE 194:** In sub-rule (4) of rule 194 of the Rules of Procedure and Conduct of Business in the National Assembly, 2007, for the brackets and figure “(iii)” the brackets and letter “(c)” shall be substituted.

- (3) **AMENDMENT IN RULE 250:** In the Rules of Procedure and Conduct of Business in the National Assembly, 2007, for the first proviso to rule 250, the following shall be substituted, namely:-

“Provided that notices of intention to move for leave to introduce a Bill or a motion for leave to amend these Rules, a notice of amendment in a Bill, or notice of question and a question of privilege shall not lapse.”

1. **INSERTION OF NEW RULE 86A.** In the Rules of Procedure and Conduct of Business in the National Assembly, 2007, after rule 86, the following new rule 86A, shall be added, namely:-

“86A. (1) If any member during the question hour or afterwards brings into the notice of the Speaker that the answer of the starred or unstarred question is based on wrong information, the Speaker may give opportunity to the Minister concerned to explain to the satisfaction of the member who has given the notice of the question.

(2) If the member concerned is still not satisfied from the explanation he or any other member may move a motion to refer the matter to a Special Committee to be constituted under rule 244(B).

(3) The Committee in the presence of the member concerned will proceed and submit its report to the House within thirty days, extendable by the Speaker for any pragmatic reason but not more than thirty days.

(4) If the House is not in session the report of the Committee will be taken up in the first sitting after the question hour.

(5) The report of the Committee shall state the actual misreporting and the names of the officials involved therein and further recommend the action to be taken.”
