AMENDMENTS TO THE RULES OF PROCEDURE AND CONDUCT OF BUSINESS IN THE NATIONAL ASSEMBLY, 2007

4. **SYED KHURSHEED AHMED SHAH**, Minister for Religious Affairs to seek leave under sub-rule (4) of rule 293 of the Rules of Procedure and Conduct of Business in the National Assembly, 2007 to move the following amendments in the said rules:-

(1) AMENDMENT IN RULE 154

That in rule 154 of the Rules of Procedure and Conduct of Business in the National Assembly, 2007, for sub-rule (7), the following shall be substituted, namely:-

“(7) If a Bill transmitted to the Senate is rejected or not passed within 90 days of its laying in the Senate, or is passed by the Senate with amendment but not passed by the Assembly with such amendment, any Minister, in the case of a Government Bill, or, in any other case, any member may, after giving two days notice, move that the Bill be considered in a joint sitting.”

(2) AMENDMENT IN RULE 170

That in rule 170 of the Rules of Procedure and Conduct of Business in the National Assembly, 2007, in sub-rule (5), between the words “of” and “Parliamentary”, the words and comma “Law, Justice and” shall be inserted.

(3) AMENDMENT IN RULE 175

That in rule 175 of the Rules of Procedure and Conduct of Business in the National Assembly, 2007, in sub-rule (1),-

- (i) for the word “two, occurring in the first line, the word “one” shall be substituted; and
- (ii) between the words “of” and “Parliamentary”, the words and comma “Law, Justice and” shall be inserted.

(4) AMENDMENT IN RULE 200

That in rule 200 of the Rules of Procedure and Conduct of Business in the National Assembly, 2007, in sub-rule (1), for the word “seventeen” the word “twenty” shall be substituted.

(5) AMENDMENT IN RULE 202

That in rule 202 of the Rules of Procedure and Conduct of Business in the National Assembly, 2007, in sub-rule (1), for the word “nineteen” the words “twenty three” shall be substituted.

(6) AMENDMENT IN RULE 244(C)

That in rule 244 (C) of the Rules of Procedure and Conduct of Business in the National Assembly, 2007, after sub-rule (4), the following new sub-rule (5), shall be added, namely:-

“(5) The Committee may make rules for regulating its procedure.”
