AMENDMENTS TO THE RULES OF PROCEDURE AND CONDUCT OF BUSINESS IN THE NATIONAL ASSEMBLY, 2007.

13. **SYED ALLA-UD-DIN** to seek leave under sub-rule (4) of rule 293 of the Rules of Procedure and Conduct of Business in the National Assembly, 2007 to move the following amendments:-

(1) **Amendment in Rule 18.**- In the Rules of Procedure and Conduct of Business in the National Assembly, 2007, hereinafter referred to as the said Rules, for sub- rule (1) of rule 18, the following shall be substituted namely:-

“(1) The Speaker may allow a member to raise a matter which is not a point of order to draw the attention of the Minister concerned, and the Minister concerned will make a brief statement. No further question or debate will be allowed.”

(2) **Amendment in Rule 40.**- In the said Rules, in sub-rule (2) of rule 40, after the word and comma “debate,” and before the word “that”, the words and comma “regarding single or collective applications,” shall be inserted.

(3) **Amendment in Rule 87.**- In the said Rules, in sub-rule (1) of rule 87, the words and comma “before taking up last calling attention notice,” shall be omitted.

(4) **Amendment in Rule 92.**- In the said Rules, in the proviso to rule 92, for the words “at the end of the sitting”, the words “as appeared in the Orders of the Day” shall be substituted.

(5) **Amendment in Rule 194.**- In the said Rules, for sub-rule (3) of rule 194, the following shall be substituted, namely:-

“(3) When several cut motions relating to the same demand are tabled the cut motions similar under the category provided in rule 189 will be clubbed together and one member from that category will be allowed to move the cut motion for all movers of that category and thereafter all members of that category will be given opportunity to speak on cut motion in the order in which the heads to which they relate appear in the budget.”
