*(Deferred from 27th Session)*

*Will the Minister for Interior be pleased to state:*

- (a) *whether it is a fact that Registrar Office being a regulator, has taken notice that Bahria Enclave, a Housing Project of Bahria Town in Islamabad, has failed to give physical possession of plots to their legitimate allottees, who have deposited full payment of their plots, despite the lapse of several years; if so, the details thereof;*
- (b) *did the Registrar Office make the administration of Bahria Enclave accountable in this regard; if so, the details thereof;*
- (c) *the corrective measure being taken by the Registrar Office to compel the administration of Bahria Enclave to give physical possession of the plots to allottees at an earliest; and*
- (d) *time by which, physical possession of the allotment of the above will be made to allottees?*

(Deferred from 27th Session)

*Will the Minister for Interior be pleased to state:*

- (a) *the rate of crimes during 2020 as compared to the last year (2019);*
- (b) *the detail of nature of crimes which have been increased or decreased as well; and*
- (c) *the number of criminals waiting for execution alongwith the detail of those convicted for imprisonment for life in jails?*

**Minister for Interior (Sheikh Rashid Ahmed):** (a) In this regard, It is submitted that crime rate of serious offences has decreased manifold due to better strategy and measures being adopted by ICT Police. Cases of kidnapping for ransom decreased by 50%, cases of robbery decreased by 18.42%, cases of dacoities decreased by 6,7.74%, cases of burglaries decreased by 34.27%, cases of general theft decreased by 26.89%, cases of auto mobile theft decreased by 3.64% and cases for fatal accidents decreased by 16.92%. 1053 cases under Arms Ordinance were registered in 2020 as compared to 718 cases in year 2019. 1215 cases under Prohibition Ordinance were registered in 2020 as compared to 1000 cases in 2019. The requisite data is enclosed as **Annexure “A”**.

**Minister for Interior (Sheikh Rashid Ahmed):** (a) As per past practice Cattle Market was organized / established for 13 days for Eid-Ul- Azha from 1st Zil Haj to 13th Zil Haj in Sector I-11 up till 2015. Now the Municipal Cattle Market is established in Sector I-12/2 as site was marked by the Planning Wing CDA.

(b) The Municipal Cattle Market is organized thorough open Auction since beginning for 13th Days in a year. According to the TORs it is the sole responsibility of the contractor to provide water, passage at Cattle Market. However the boundary wall cannot be constructed, because of temporary allocation of land for holding the cattle market for 13 days.

*Will the Minister for Interior be pleased to state:*

- (a) *when was the last routine maintenance work carried out at Shakarparian road;*
- (b) *the criteria to determine the condition of a road for maintenance work;*
- (c) *whether the said road fulfill the criteria of a good condition road;*
- (d) *if the answer to part (c) above is in affirmative, what steps are being taken by the Government in this regard?*

**Minister for Interior (Sheikh Rashid Ahmed):** (a) The routine maintenance work of Shakarparian road is carried out a week ago on 16-11-2020. However routine patch work also carried out as and when required.

(b) The Shakarparian road condition for maintenance work determined /observed during site visit of field staff by visual inspection.

(c) yes partially.

(d) The estimate has been prepared for rehabilitation / widening of Shakarparian road with increased width from 20 feet to 24 feet. Estimate is under approval and work will be started within this financial year after fulfillment of codal formalities.

108. **\*Ch. Muhammad Barjees Tahir:**

*Will the Minister for Inter-Provincial Coordination be pleased to state:*

- (a) *the reasons behind the downfall of sports in the country; and*
- (b) *what steps are being taken by the Government to take all type of sports to the top levels of the list of all international sports?*

**Minister for Inter-Provincial Coordination (Dr. Fehmida Mirza):**

(a) The main reasons of downfall can be attributed to the following:—

- ❖ Lack of funds in the sports sector.
- ❖ Lack of sports infrastructure.
- ❖ Lack of modern equipment's.
- ❖ After 18th Amendments, Sports devolved to the provinces accordingly resources are with the provinces, No uniformity amongst the provinces.
- ❖ No coordination among sports bodies in the country like sports federations, POA and absence of genuine sports federations.
- ❖ Lack of genuine sports clubs at the local levels.
- ❖ No sports nurseries at local schools level and the club.
- ❖ Political appointment of District Sports Officer.
- ❖ Lack of proper coaches.
- ❖ Selection of athletes without merits.

(b) To revamp the sports bodies, for the first time, all sports stakeholders have been taken on board for working on new sports structure and sports policy.

109. **\*Moulana Abdul Akbar Chitrali:**

*Will the Minister for Interior be pleased to state:*

- (a) *whether it is a fact that in Sector I-14, Islamabad, roads are ruptured/damaged, street lights are not installed, public parks and other utilities are not available for residents;*

- (b) *whether it is also a fact that poor infrastructure and unavailable/substandard basic facilities for inhabitants shows incompetence of CDA management; and*
- (c) *what steps are being taken by the CDA for betterment of infrastructure, specifically, for roads of the said sector?*

**Minister for Interior (Sheikh Rashid Ahmed):** (a)

**Road condition:**

Yes, it is fact that Roads in Sector I-14 are not in good conditions, Revised PC-I is approved and tenders are called for carpeting of Roads.

**Street Lights:**

it is submitted that the tender for the work “providing/installation of Road Lights at Major Roads III & IV in Sector I-14, Islamabad” has been called and shall be opened on 10-02-2021. The estimate for the remaining Major Roads and sub-sector of I-14 are under process and tenders shall be called on the Financial year 2020-21.

**Utilities:**

water supply line for sector I-14, Islamabad has already been laid but water could not be supplied due to non-completion of peripheral main in Sector I-14 (along service road North) and main conduction line from Shah Allah Ditta Reservoir (source of water) in different pockets due to land possession. However, efforts are being made to get the safe land possession for early completion of the leftover work.

(b) 80% of Road Network in sector I-14 have been completed tender for carpeting of Road under process.

(c) As above.

110. **\*Sheikh Rohale Asghar:**

*Will the Minister for Interior be pleased to state:*

- (a) *whether it is a fact that extra amount has been demanded by the Senate Cooperative Housing Society, Islamabad from members;*

- (b) *whether the lay out plan has approved thereof; if so, the date on which it was approved;*
- (c) *whether a society can make development without existing of layout plan; if so, under what law alongwith the details thereof;*
- (d) *if society can not make development; if so, the reasons for demanding extra amount;*
- (e) *the number of members who have submitted complete amount including development charges so far; and*
- (f) *the details like names, membership number and other details thereof?*

**Minister for Interior (Sheikh Rashid Ahmed):** (a) The Senate (Sectt) Employees Cooperative Housing Society Islamabad has not demanded any extra amount against cost of land from members who have already been allotted with plot numbers and have paid cost of land. However, cost of land has been revised for those members who have only deposited meager amounts and for whom the land is yet to be purchased on present market rates there are a big number of such members who have only deposited Rs. 5000/- against their cost of plot, hence without revision in cost, the project cannot be developed and delivered.

(b) Yes, the layout plan of society over an area of 679 kanal was approved by CDA in year 2009 and same piece of land is to be developed at first stage.

(c) Yes, the approved layout plan of the society exists accordingly.

(d) The development at site will have to be made at the earliest as the project is already delayed and cost of development is rising day by day. The rate of development has been determined uniformly for all members as all the development has to be made on current market rates.

(e) There are 2701 members who have not deposited complete cost of land out of which 2387 are such who have just deposited less than 25% towards their installments. The development charges from members are yet to be received.

(f) Under compilation, will be provided shortly.

111. **\*Syed Agha Rafiullah:**

*Will the Minister for Interior be pleased to state:*

- (a) *whether CDA has conducted building audit of the Parliament House with regard to environmental impact on human lives, particularly with reference to unprecedented alteration in the original master plan;*
- (b) *if so, the details thereof; and whether or not finding of such audit has been forwarded to the administration of Secretariats of National Assembly and Senate;*
- (c) *if not, whether there is any proposal under consideration to conduct building audit of Parliament House, particularly with reference to alteration made in the building over and above its master plan; if so, the details thereof?*

**Minister for Interior (Sheikh Rashid Ahmed):** (a) Particularly with reference to unprecedented alteration in original Master Plan, no building audit of Parliament House with regards to environmental impact on human lives has been conducted by CDA (Coordination) Dte, Parliament House.

(b) Not conducted.

(c) No proposal in process regarding conducting of such audit.

112. **\*Ms. Nafeesa Inayatullah Khan Khattak:**

*Will the Minister for Overseas Pakistanis and Human Resource Development be pleased to state the steps taken by the Human Resource Development Wing of this Ministry at present in order to align Pakistan National Labour Laws at par with international obligations on available labour standards?*

**Minister for Overseas Pakistanis and Human Resource Development:** After the 18th Constitutional Amendment, the enactment of labour legislation and enforcement is the Provincial subject, however, International Treaties, Conventions and Agreements and International Arbitrations rests with the Federal Government. Under the Rules of Business, 1973,

this Ministry has been assigned the functions for keeping a watch on labour legislations from international perspective, coordination of labour legislations in Pakistan, dealing and agreements with international organizations in the fields of labour and social security.

However, since the devolution of labour legislation and enforcement to Provinces, the Federal Government has developed different frameworks, conducted gap analysis of ILO Conventions viz a viz labour laws, initiated Decent Work Country Programme in collaboration with ILO Country Office, applied for initiation of Better Work Programme in Pakistan, enhanced institutional capacity to prepare periodical reports on ILO Conventions, established a Federal Tripartite Consultation Committee for debate and consensus based decision making on labour issues and most recently has processed the case for constitution of Inter-Ministerial Labour Committee of Pakistan. The aim of all these activities is to bring awareness amongst the Provinces about the international commitments of Pakistan and to align Labour Laws at par with international obligations.

113. **\*Dr. Mahreen Razzaq Bhutto:**

*Will the Minister for Interior be pleased to state:*

- (a) *the detail of complaints received since last two years for treatment of leakage/seepage of water from roof and whitewash of Government quarters in Sector F-6, Islamabad; and*
- (b) *steps being taken by the CDA for redressal the said complaints?*

**Minister for Interior (Sheikh Rashid Ahmed):** (a) The total number of complaints 279 received *w.e.f.* 1st July, 2018 to 30th June, 2020 in Sector F-6, detail is as under:–

114. **\*Shazia Marri:**

*Will the Minister for Interior be pleased to state:*

- (a) *whether Ministry has taken notice of increasing trend of abusive and threatening campaign against women journalists on social media; if so, the details thereof;*
- (b) *whether the persons involved in such toxic campaign have been apprehended; if so, the details thereof; if not reasons thereof; and*
- (c) *what corrective or propective steps are being taken by the Government in this regard?*

**Minister for Interior (Sheikh Rashid Ahmed):** (a) Cybercrime Wing-FIA is in the process of establishing Cyber Patrolling Unit (CPU), the main purpose of which is monitoring of social media/cyber space and pointing out social media trend covering different subjects of interest like, harassment of women journalists etc. Budget for CPU has been allocated and it will start functioning in 2/3 months positively.

(b) Cybercrime Wing-FIA has complaint based system. Furthermore cybercrime wing FIA has received only one complaint of Ms. Maham Waseem anchor of AbbTakk news which is under enquiry (Re-242/20). The threat, defamation through social media are dealt with under section 20, 24 of PECA Act 2016, which is non-cognizable.

(c) Cybercrime Wing FIA apart from investigation periodically initiates cybercrime awareness in general public through electronic/social media.

115. **\*Mr. Iqbal Muhammad Ali Khan:**

*Will the Minister for Inter-Provincial Coordination be pleased to state:*

- (a) *whether it is a fact that Pakistan Cricket Board (PCB) has recently, appealed in the World Court of Arbitration against the decision of its own-appointed independent adjudicator, reducing the ban on Test Cricket Umar Akmal from 36 months to 18 months in two different cases registered under the PCB Anti-Corruption Code of Conduct;*

- (b) *if so, the justification thereof;*
- (c) *the expenditure which has been incurred upon the cases so far, expected to be incurred till the finality of the case;*
- (d) *whether PCB has hired services of any private lawyer to plead the case in World Court of Arbitration; and*
- (e) *if so, the expenditure incurred thereupon and justification to not let the legal team of PCB to plead the case by itself?*

**Minister for Inter-Provincial Coordination (Dr. Fehmida Mirza):**

(a) & (b) Pakistan Cricket Board (PCB) has filed an e-appeal before the Court of Arbitration for Sports (CAS) in accordance with the provisions of the PCB Anti-Corruption Code for Participants (the “Code”) against the decision of the Independent Adjudicator through which Umer Akmal’s ban has been reduced from 36 months to 18 months.

PCB proceeded with filing an appeal against the Independent Adjudicator’s decision before CAS as it felt that the grounds relied upon for the partial reduction of Umer Akmal’s ban were extraneous and ultra vires the applicable Anti-Corruption Code (the ‘Code’). The reasoning behind PCB’s decision was two-fold:

- a. Firstly; the Independent Adjudicator misdirected itself and misapplied the provision of the Code when after reaching the conclusion that there is no room for doubt as to the veracity of charges against Umer Akmal and further holding that the case against him stands proved to the hilt, went on to reduce the period of ineligibility which could only be done if the mitigating factors as enumerated under Article 6.1.2 of the Code were attracted/ applicable; and
- b. Secondly; an error in application of Article 6.3.2 of the Code was made. The two incidents/breaches, for which Umer Akmal was charged, are separate and distinct, and hence the period of ineligibility are to run cumulatively and not concurrently.

Even otherwise PCB has zero tolerance towards corruption in any form or manifestation and has been fighting the war against corruption in cricket

for decades. It may be noted that the panel of Independent Adjudicators maintained by PCB comprises former Supreme Court and High Court. judges, and their independence/neutrality is substantiated by the fact that in the instant case a decision has been made by an Independent Adjudicator which the PCB has chosen to appeal.

(c) PCB has only paid the CAS Court Office Fee amounting to (Confoederatio Helvetica Franc (CHF-1,000) equivalent to (Rs.183,540.00) in order for the case to be registered with CAS. As per the Procedural Rules of CAS, the final amount of the cost of arbitration will be determined by CAS at the end of the proceedings.

For the purposes of cutting down costs PCB has, in fact submitted an application requesting CAS to consolidate both appeals and that the same be heard together *viz* video-conference.

(d)& (e) PCB's three member in-house legal team plays a pivotal role in ensuring the fulfillment of PCB's Strategic Plan by assisting the entire organization and providing appropriate legal cover, advice and solutions whilst safeguarding PCB's interests at all times. This includes, *inter alia*:

- Preparation of bid documents and agreements in respect of PCB and PSL commercial rights.
- Litigation Management and Support
- Provision of assistance to all Departments of PCB.
- Protection of PCB's Intellectual Property Rights before the IPO and by serving legal notices to infringing parties.
- Successful negotiation and execution of out of court settlement of disputes with various rights holders.
- Drafting rules and regulations for PCB – most recent being the Anti-Racism Code, Regulations for the Registration of Agents, Code of Conduct for Player and Player Support Personnel etc.

As the in-house legal team is constantly engaged in dealing with in-house matters, the PCB engaged the services of M/S Rizvi and Rizvi, with Mr. Taffazul Rizvi acting as lead counsel in the matter. Mr. Rizvi has remained on PCB's panel of lawyers for over a decade; is a litigation expert and an Advocate for the Honorable Supreme Court of Pakistan; and has vast prior experience in dealing with proceedings under the Code. In this regard, Mr. Rizvi has played an important role in PCB's fight against Corruption in Cricket. Mr. Rizvi is not charging any professional legal fees for the Appeal filed on behalf of the PCB.

116. **\*Mst. Shaheen Naz Saifullah:**

*Will the Minister for Interior be pleased to state:*

- (a) *the details of basic requirements for consideration of obtaining driving licence in Pakistan;*
- (b) *whether the tests of basic education and drugs are conducted for seeking licence;*
- (c) *if the answers to part (a) and (b) above are in affirmative, as to when clear strategy would be formulated in this regard?*

**Minister for Interior (Sheikh Rashid Ahmed):** (a) Islamabad Traffic Police has adopted Punjab Motor Vehicle Ordinance 1965 & Motor Vehicle Rules -1969. Islamabad Traffic Police issues driving license according to section 4 to 12 of Motor Vehicle Ordinance 1965 and Rules No. 2 to 22 of Motor Vehicle Rules 1969.

**Eligibility Criteria:**

- ❖ Physical fitness is mandatory as per section 4 (2), 7(3) & 15 of MVO-1965.
- ❖ **Age Limit:**
  - Bike / Car / Jeep 18 Years
  - Light Transport Vehicle (LTV) 21 Years

- Heavy Transport Vehicle (HTV) 22 Years  
(having 03 years old DL)
- Public Service Vehicle (PSV) 22 Years  
(having 01 year old DL)

**PROCEDURE:**

- **Learner** Issued without any assessment/test
  - **Learner period** 42 days learner period after issuance of learner permit.
  - **Practical Test**
    - ❖ Traffic Sign Test
    - ❖ Driving Test within premises- Question Mark and “S” Shapes
- (b) \*
- 01 hour class on traffic rules & regulations is being conducted in the premises of ITP HQ which is mandatory prior to appear before theory/practical test.
  - Physical fitness is mandatory as per section 4(2), 7(3) & 15 of MVO-1965 on prescribed Form-B. However, if any applicant shows any evidence of being addicted to the excessive use of alcohol, tobacco or drugs, then he is declared medically unfit to apply for driving license as per law scheduled II Form B.
- (c) Existing Rules & Regulations are being observed for issuance/renewal of driving licenses in Federal Capital.

117. \*Ms. Shams Un Nisa:

*Will the Minister for Interior be pleased to state the statistics of street crime in Islamabad and its counter measures?*

**Minister for Interior (Sheikh Rashid Ahmed):** It is submitted that the comparative statement from 01-01-2019 to 30-09-2020 and 30-09-2020 regarding street crimes *i.e.* Purse/Mobile/Jewellery/Cash and Vehicle/Motorcycle snatching is as under:—

The above said data shows that there is a considerable decrease in the street crimes due to better strategy adopted by ICT Police to curb the crimes/criminals. The following steps have been taken by ICT Police to curb the crime/criminals involved in street crimes *i.e.* Purse/Mobile/Jewellery/Cash and Vehicle/Motorcycle snatching:-

- In order to improve the security within Federal Capital and for the prevention and detection of crimes within ICT the Government established a “Safe City Project” covering almost all the roads through IP Cameras and Islamabad Traffic Police is also integrated with this project. The said project is under the direct supervision of District Administration, ICT, Islamabad. **1800** CCTV cameras have been installed at the conspicuous entry and exit points. Round the clock monitoring of these cameras is being carried out by expert staff under the supervision of apt officers and technical experts. The ICT police has been successful in identifying crimes and also in tracing out criminal cases through these measures.
- Under the Government policy, a proactive strategy was adopted by the senior command of ICT Police to provide better policing to general public of ICT for their security/safety.

- The patrolling system within ICT has been revamped and 15 Falcons and 16 pairs of Eagle Motorcycle alongwith 06 Commandos vehicles have been deployed which is working in three shifts for surveillance and to control Street Crimes. Besides this, the SHO's of all Police Stations within ICT have been strictly directed to utilize their mobiles as well as staff from Rescue-15 to curb this menace.
- The Federal Capital has been divided into **44** beats and experienced officers have been deputed in each beat to watch the activities of suspects. One Falcon (Vehicle) is patrolling each beat.
- Moreover to make Islamabad Capital, a crime free city, the ICT Police took following steps as well as preventive measures to curb the crime/criminals generally and street crime specially:-
  - Crime cluster Analysis.
  - Data Base (survey of Kochi Abadies).
  - Intelligence Based Policing.
  - Joint Patrolling with Pak Rangers.
  - Random checking of Guest Houses/Hotel/Motel.
  - Surprise checking.
  - Surveillance of suspected Elements.
  - Data proofing of released prisoners.

In a nutshell the Islamabad Capital Territory Police performing its duties round the clock to nab the criminals and create a sense of security among the citizens of Islamabad. Special emphasis is being put to foot patrol in commercial and residential beats for effective engagement of community for prevention of street crimes. Eagle Squads/Motorcycle patrol is in place in all the sectors of Islamabad.

*Will the Minister for Overseas Pakistanis and Human Resource Development be pleased to state:*

**Minister for Overseas Pakistanis and Human Resource Development:** (a) The out break of corona virus pandemic affected the economies of the countries around the world including the labour migration *i.e.* layoffs, job losses especially in Gulf Cooperation Council (GCC) countries. Pakistan is a major beneficiary of labour migration and Pakistani workers also returned home due to this pandemic. No separate data for returning workers was maintained.

However, Overseas Employment Corporation (OEC), an Autonomous Body of Ministry of Overseas Pakistanis and Human Resource Development has launched a Portal on 9th June, 2020 for registration of returning workers. Further, since the Covid-19 pandemic hit, **78,361** returned workers have been registered with the OEC portal till 31-12-2020. Out of which, **35,281** are from Saudi Arabia, **5,740** from UAE and **2,655** from Oman.

(b) Bureau of Emigration & Overseas Employment (BE&OE), an Attached Department of Ministry of Overseas Pakistanis and Human Resource Development has developed a comprehensive reintegration plan / strategy for returning migrant workers by:

- i. Collection and compilation of data for impact assessment and addressing challenges to labour migration and sharing of the same with all the stakeholders.
- ii. Facilitating returnees to obtain jobs in national and international job markets through up-skilling and certification.
- iii. Facilitating the interested returnees to set up their own businesses through Small and Medium Enterprises Development Authority (SMEDA), National Youth Development Framework (NYDF) etc.

- iv. Loans for Entrepreneurship, Ehsaas Cash Transfer, Ehsaas School Fee programs and there informal labour registration with EOBI.

Moreover, BE&OE has also developed a diversification strategy for promoting/ enhancing the export of manpower to potential/ non-traditional countries such as Japan, Germany, Canada, Romania, Belgium and Portugal.

**Minister for Inter-Provincial Coordination (Dr. Fehmida Mirza):**

(a) & (b) The team's performance after each tour is discussed internally on PCB's Cricket Committee, comprising of ex-cricketers and senior PCB officials, which in the past has held players and support staff accountable for team's performances and the same had resulted in changing of Captain, Head Coaches and Selection Committee. After each tour, input is sought from the relevant officials on team's performance and other on-tour matters, and the same are evaluated internally. Important cricketing matters are forwarded to the Cricket Committee for investigation and recommendation, in light of which a decision is taken by the PCB management. A clear recent example of such

evaluation-cum-investigation was the change of Chief Selector, Head Coach and National. Team Captain after the ICC Cricket World Cup 2019. PCB believes in clear and robust evaluation of national team players and its team officials and ensures that the respective player(s)/official(s) are held responsible for their performance.

(c) & (d) Pakistan Cricket Board (PCB) has been established under the Sports (Development and Control) Ordinance 1962 as a body corporate with perpetual succession and through its Constitution issued vide SRO No. 1045(1)/2019 dated 19th August 2019 (the “PCB Constitution”) regulates, administers, manages and promotes the game of cricket in Pakistan as an autonomous governing body.

PCB is a unique entity in that although established by the Federal Government, it is not controlled by it; neither seeks nor takes any grants, funds or monies from either the Government or Public Exchequer; and in fact, generates its own revenues to reinvest in the development of cricket in the country.

It is also important to bring to your notice that by virtue of being an ICC Full Member, all National Cricket Federations such as the PCB are required to put in place a democratic and transparent system of corporate governance, and Article 2.4(D) of the ICC Articles of Association seeks to minimize the interference/involvement of the government in the functioning of the respective National Cricket Federations. In fact, as- has been evidenced in the past with the Sri Lankan Cricket Board and the Cricket Association of Nepal where ICC suspended their memberships with the ICC due to government interference in their respective boards, the loss suffered through such suspension is irreparable as all accruing rights are frozen along with all financial distributions and decision-making powers at the ICC Board level.

Clause 3(3) of the PCB Constitution requires PCB to operate independently and in a transparent manner to ensure that all decisions are made on merit and in the best interests of Pakistan cricket. Hence, the PCB Constitution whilst incorporating a new structure for domestic cricket from the grass root level and above also aims to adhere to the best corporate governance practices to ensure across the board accountability and provide a nurturing environment for the development of cricket in Pakistan.

PCB ensures and implements high levels of corporate and financial governance and management. It is also pertinent to note that PCB has instilled a robust financial management system and undergoes external and internal audits which are conducted by internationally acclaimed firms of Chartered Accountants such as Deloitte Yousaf Adil and Ernst & Young Ford Rhodes Sidat Hyder, respectively, whilst A.F. Fergusons (PricewaterhouseCoopers) & Co act as Tax Advisors. Annual audit reports and periodical internal audit reports are available and the same may be perused on the official PCB website.

(d) After completion of inquiry by NAB proceedings will be started for recovery of embezzled amount from EX-Managing Committee if pointed out in the inquiry report.

(e) The sale / purchase of plots of actual members who are genuine allottees cannot be banned in the public interest. However, 54 allottees of Agro Farms plots whose inquiries are pending in NAB are not allowed by Managing Committee for sale / purchase of these plots.

**DETAIL OF PROTECTIVE MEASURES TAKEN BY THE  
INCUMBENT GOVERNMENT IN ORDER TO STOP ILLEGAL  
TRADE/SUPPLY OF DRUGS OR DRUG TRAFFICKING INSIDE, AS  
WELL AS OUTSIDE (INTERNAL AND EXTERNAL DRUG  
TRAFFICKING) IN COUNTRY**

1. The Steps taken/ being taken by the Anti Narcotics Force for controlling of drug smuggling are as under:
  - a. Source/ informer's cultivation & acquisition of actionable intelligence at all entry & exit points of the country.
  - b. Launching of campaigns/ crackdown against drug peddlers involving Police and other LEAs under IATF forum.
  - c. Destruction of Poppy Crops in coordination with Provincial Govt.
  - d. Training and extensive use of Canine Units (sniffer dogs) at each Regional Directorate.

- e. Capacity building of ANF officials and other Law Enforcement Agencies (LEAs) through training and provision of equipment for counter narcotics activities.
- f. Intelligence network of ANF has been expanded inside main cities to locate and hunt drug smugglers/peddlers.
- g. Conduct of precursors training for all users for effective precursor control/checking.
- h. Random/surprise checking by ANF Special Squads at all railway stations/medical/medicine chemical industries.
- i. Scope of Port Control Unit (PCU) at Karachi has been expanded. Checking of imports at seaports has also commenced despite paucity of resources.
- j. Frequent engagement with courier and parcel companies and efforts are in hand to get approval of extension of NADRA Biometric Verification System to them.
- k. To monitor the trafficking and use of synthetic drugs, stringent measures are being taken. With regard to diversion of precursors for manufacturing of narcotics drugs, an elaborate SOP has been formulated and being implemented in letter and spirit.
- l. Re-orientation of the force with more focus towards intelligence led operations/ seizures. For this purpose, intelligence sections have been made more effective / operational at RD level. This move has reaped positive rewards in the shape of locating and hunting down drug traffickers and street peddlers.
- m. Raising of Coastal Regional Directorate is under process at Gwadar to overcome counter international trafficking.
- n. There has been significant growth in the illicit trafficking of drugs / narcotics including its methods and techniques. Scheduled offenders at present are using modern techniques and devices for trafficking of drugs. However, ANF which is the prime counter narcotics agency in Pakistan is not included in the list of Fair Trial Act. If same is available to ANF its efficiency will enhance manifold.
- o. Various locations have been earmarked for establishment of ANF Police Station/Post, but are pending due to lack of essential manpower/equipment and finance.

- p. Non availability of Forensic lab for ANF and checking of samples from other labs is a time-consuming practice.
- q. Allotment of funds and establishment of Model Addiction Treatment & Rehabilitation Centers (MATRCs), will help in spread of drugs locally. Role of provinces in this regard head lot of in improvement.
- r. Inter Agencies Task Force (IATF) has been established under the supervision of ANF to maximize the effectiveness of Anti Narcotics Policy through coordinated implementation of the Counter Narcotics Enforcement Strategy, with a view to make Pakistan a drug free state.
- s. On the vision of Prime Minister (PM), “Drug free Islamabad 2020” campaign has been launched throughout the year. In this regard, joint operations followed by routine operations basis on information gathered from arrested individuals have been carried out with Islamabad Capital Territory (ICT) Police Islamabad.
- t. **FM-101.** Dedicated time from 03:00 pm to 04:00 pm has been earmarked for ANF where masses are being given awareness on drugs and its adverse effects.

**Minister for Overseas Pakistanis and Human Resource Development:** (a) The Pakistani migrant workers employed abroad get their salaries according to the Foreign Service Agreements signed between them and

the recruiting agency authorized by their employers. The terms and conditions of the jobs are mentioned therein. In certain cases, the salaries of nationals of the host country can be higher than the migrant workers from labour exporting countries including Pakistan. The equality between national and migrant workers is determined under the laws of host country / bilateral agreements and the internationally binding Treaties which the host country has ratified.

(b) Most countries however do not share the information about such differences of salaries. Hence, it is difficult to ascertain the reasons.

(c) Pakistan Government is committed to provide equal opportunities and rights to all our migrant workers and this aspect is ensured during negotiations at bilateral and multilateral levels. At the time of grant of permission for recruitment against a foreign job, it is also ensured that the terms and conditions of the jobs are reasonable according to the cost of living and conditions in that country.

**Minister for Interior (Sheikh Rashid Ahmed):** - During the anti-encroachment drive conducted in last three years in Islamabad, CDA did not demolish any old or already established Mosque.

- However, CDA has only taken action against those new illegal constructions of Mosques which were in violation of Master Plan of Islamabad as well as prevailing rules & regulations of CDA.

**Minister for Interior (Sheikh Rashid Ahmed):** (a) Rawal Enclave is not a Cooperative Society. It is an illegal Scheme running by M/s Raja Majid & Raja Naseer.

(b) The Authority *vide* its letter No. CDA/PLW/RP-1(2)(36)/2014/577, Dated 19-04-2018, CDA/PLW/RP-1(2)(36)/2014/505, dated 26-11-2020, had directed warned them to stop making any publicity / marking /sale of plots and making any type of development /construction in this illegal housing scheme.

(c) No, CDA has not allowed electricity and gas. However, electricity and gas has been installed in the Scheme.

(d) Rawal Enclave is not a Cooperative Society. It is an illegal scheme running by M/s Raja Majid & Raja Naseer. No record of sale / purchase of plots is vests with CDA. The Authority did not allow any kind of marketing to the illegal scheme. So such actions had illegally been performed by the scheme owners.

(e) CDA has requested the general public through public notices and CDA website to refrain from any sought of investment in such illegal schemes. In spite of such requests and notices the general public has taken risks and invested in such schemes without consulting and confirmation of the legality of such Schemes from CDA.

(f) This is private business deal with the sponsors of scheme without involving CDA. Thus, CDA cannot direct the sponsors for refund of payments.

(g) As replied above.

(h) As replied above.

(i) The Authority *vide* its letter No. CDA/PLW/RP-1(2)(36)/2014/577, dated 19-04-2018, & dated 26-11-2020, had directed / warned them to stop making any publicity/ marketing/ sale of plots and making any type of development/ construction in this illegal housing scheme. CDA in collaboration of with ICT administration & ICT police performed several actions against the said scheme, CDA on 19-10-2020 with the collaboration Enforcement performed operation against Rawal Enclave and site offices of the scheme had been sealed. No Project is under consideration to store the said water, however, the Project of Chirah Dam proposed to be constructed downstream of Simly Dam on River Soan may be able to store the water released from Simly Dam Reservoir depending upon its storage capacity. The Chirah Dam is being constructed by the Small Dams Organization Irrigation Department, Government of Punjab.

The main reasons of defay are non-possession, litigation and non-clearance of BUPs compensation to the affectees. The concerned Land & Rehabilitations Directorate of Estate Management Wing is on task to resolve the non-possession issues.

- The awards of BUP/Land was announced on 1985 to 1987 against villages Dhrake Mohri, Bhekar Fateh Bukhsh, Bhekar Akku' falls in

Sector E-12. There are 1277 (491 BUP and 786 Land plots) yet to be allotted in regards to be compensation against BUP / Land for affectees of Sector E-12.

(b) - The fresh/new PC- Iw of entire E-12 Sector amounting to Rs. 6630.21 (Million) has been approved by CDA-DWP held on 02-10-2020. The Development work in Sector E-12 has been started and the work for Construction of Service Road (North), E-12 is in progress after demolishing encroachments from alignment of said road. The Financial bids for the Development work of Sector E-12 (Construction of Road Network, Water Supply and Sanitary Sewerage System of Sub Sector E-12/2 & E-12/3, Islamabad) amongst technically qualified firms shall be opened on 12-10-2020. The estimation work regarding development of remaining Sector is also under process.

- The compensation of these remaining affectees is in process under the supervision of Committee constituted by Honorable Islamabad High Court. The compensation may be given after the direction of Islamabad High Court, Commission and after approval of Competent Authority. Thereafter, the total possession of Sector E-12 be given to Directorate of Sector Development, CDA for development work, Moreover, it is intimated that development work of North Service Road of Sector E-12 has already been in process.

**Minister for Interior (Sheikh Rashid Ahmed):** \* PC-I of the scheme titled “Construction of Model Prison at Sector H-16, Islamabad” was approved for Rs. 3928.523 million by ECNEC on 20-07-2016.

- \* Execution of project is the responsibility of Pak PWD.
- \* An amount of Rs. 1427.162 million has been utilized so far.
- \* 25% work has so far been awarded to the contractors.
- \* Later on it was pointed out that the project falls in buffer zone and 78 ft in Right of Way of 17th Avenue.

- Due to above hurdles the project suffer delay in timely executing.
- In order to remove the hurdles this Administration has requested to CDA through Ministry of Interior to submit summaries for the Federal Cabinet for approval regarding change in the Master Plan required to boost up the progress of the project.
- The Cabinet approved the Amendment in the Master Plan of Islamabad to the extent of adjustment in the alignment of 17th Avenue due to westwards displacement of boundary wall of Model Prison in Sector H-16, Islamabad vide case No.426/Rule-19/2020,dated 26-06-2020.
- CDA intimated that implementation of decision is subject to approval of Permission to use Green Area / Buffer Zone in the Northern Half of Sector H-16/2 for institution to the extent of 90 Acres land, as allotted to Model Prison in Green Area / Buffer Zone in the Northern Half of Sector H-16/2.
- Therefore, another summary was submitted to the Cabinet on 08-09-2020 and the Cabinet directed vide case No. 690/37/2020, dated 22-09-2020 that The Attorney General for Pakistan, assisted by Secretary Interior Division and Chairman CDA, shall apprise the Chief Justices of Supreme Court and Islamabad High Court about the fact of environmental violations committed by constructing the prison in the Green / Buffer Zone and will also convey reservations of the Cabinet on this issue with a view to seeking directions; and further directed Director General FIA to initiate criminal action against delinquent CDA/PWD/ICT officers / officials as recommended in the FIA enquiry report.
- After receiving approval of the Federal Cabinet, CDA will approve the lay out Plan and design of Model Prison.
- Pak PWD submitted revised PC-I with an estimated cost of Rs. 9944.695 million for approval of the competent forum.
- After approval of the revised PC-I and permission in Buffer / Green Zone from the competent forum, work will be started efficiently for timely completion of the project.

(c) Assistant Syed Muzamil Hussain Shah, RD ANF Balochistan. Supreme Court of Pakistan, Islamabad reinstatement order dated 24 Sep 2019 was implemented and official joined his duty on 1st March 2020 w.e.f.25th October 2013.

Const. Syed Mudassir Hussain Shah, RD ANF Punjab. Federal Service Tribunal (FST), Islamabad re-instatement order dated 25 Apr 2019 was implemented and official joined his duty on 1st June 2019 w.e.f.4th August 2017.

Const. Umar Farooq, RD ANF Sindh.

FST, Islamabad reinstatement order dated 20 Dec 18 was implemented and official joined his duty on 7th May 2019 w.e.f.23rd January 2017.

Naib Qasid Zahid, RD ANF Sindh.

FST, Karachi reinstatement order dated 12 Oct 2017 was implemented and official joined his duty on 20th March 2018 w.e.f.14th May 2015.

(d) ANF implements the orders of Courts / Administrative Tribunals in strict sense as ANF believes in the Rule of Law. There are no contempt proceedings against ANF pending in Courts / Tribunals regarding non implementation of any order. However, joining of the 1 x officer namely AD Kashif Mushtaq is pending due to following reasons:—

- i. The officer has filed Review Petition before FST, Islamabad for modification of his minor penalty. The officer was awarded major penalty of Removal from Service.
