

RESOLUTION

01-08-23

This House recognizes the establishment of the Engineer Parliamentarians Caucus, whose purpose is to bolster engineering policy and advocacy in all technical matters for the Government, thereby improving quality control and boosting both export and import substitutions. The Caucus is committed to finding indigenous solutions through the linkage of engineers and subject matter experts with on-ground implementers to utilize industrial potential. The Caucus will play a pivotal role in reshaping policies for the betterment of Pakistan and fostering engineering practices in line with the best international standards.

In addition the Caucus will serve as a liaison between the Federal Government and the Pakistan Engineering Council, an apex regulatory body enacted by the Parliament (PEC Act, 1976) to regulate the engineering profession in entirety. It will advocate for and seek necessary legislative support on behalf of the engineering profession and the PEC's role as a "Think Tank" for the Federal Government.

The Caucus aims to incorporate an engineering perspective into public policy decisions, thereby improving the proactive role of the engineering profession and contributing to the socio-economic development of the country being an emerging knowledge-based, IT-driven economy of the region.
